## 17-41-301. Proposal for creation of agriculture protection area.

(1)(b)(i) To be accepted for processing by the applicable legislative body, a proposal under Subsection (1)(a) shall be signed by a majority in number of all owners of real property and the owners of a majority of the land area in *agricultural protection\** within the proposed agriculture protection area.

In order to apply for agricultural protection, the area being proposed must be evaluated based upon:			
17-41-305 Criteria to be applied in evaluating proposals for the creation of agriculture protection			
In evaluating a proposal and in determining whether or not to create or recommend the creation of an agriculture protection area, the advisory committee, planning commission, and applicable legislative body shall apply the following criteria:  (1) whether or not the land is currently being used for <i>agriculture protection*</i> ;  (2) whether or not the land is zoned for agriculture use;  (3) whether or not the land is viable for <i>agriculture production*</i> ;  (4) the extent and nature of existing or proposed farm improvements; and  (5) anticipated trends in agricultural and technological conditions.			
*NOTE: the term agricultural production is defined by state law as follows: 17-41-101. Definitions.			
(2)(a) "Agriculture production" means production for commercial purposes of crops, livestock, and livestock products.			
(b) "Agriculture production" includes the processing or retail marketing of any crops, livestock, and livestock products when more than 50% of the processed or merchandised products are produced by the farm operator.			
<b>NOTE</b> : Tooele County Code places the following limitations on the creation of agricultural protection areas:			
4-6-6. Location and minimum size for agriculture protection areas.			
To be included in an agriculture protection area established within Tooele County, land must be located in an <i>Agricultural or Multiple-use zoning district</i> and must consist of at least <i>100 contiguous acres</i> .
